Dear Parent /carer

We have a second positive case of COVID within school and a few symptomatic pupils who have stayed at home. We are putting our outbreak risk management plan into place.

Please do not send pupils to school who are symptomatic or ill, we will be being very cautious and send them home. Symptomatic pupils should get a PCR test and self-isolate whilst they await the results. The same will apply to staff. Any pupil self-isolating will be provided with free school meal vouchers if they are entitled. Online learning remains on the school website for pupils who are self-isolating and will be updated if needed.

Within school the following measure will be reinstated from tomorrow Wednesday 10th November:

Reduced visitors. Only essential visitors who support pupils directly will be in school. Annual reviews will be conducted online.

Everyone will be expected to wear face covering in corridors and when they can't social distance unless exempt, eating, drinking or exercising. School will provide masks for pupils who forget their own. Masks should be kept in the pupils pocket in a plastic bag when not being worn. This rule will also apply to staff and visitors.

Testing twice weekly in school will be reintroduced for those who have consented, if you wish your child to be tested in school and have not sent in the consent form please request a copy from the school office. Staff will also be tested on site twice per week. Visitors will be asked to show evidence of a negative lateral flow test.

We will continue to sanitise pupils and staff hands at the start of the day, beginning of each lesson, break and lunch. Good respiratory hygiene remains in place and tissues are provided in each classroom. Pupil will once again be asked to clean the desk and chair they use at the start of each lesson with an antibacterial wipe. Windows will be open to provide as much natural ventilation as possible.

The measures above are to ensure we can protect each other and try reducing further spread of COVID in school. The measures will be in place until Wednesday 17th November. The measures may be extended if we get any further cases.
